

## **Bristol Local School District Ohio Improvement Plan 2016-17**

**Goal #1:** By the end of the 2016-17 school year, the district will meet or exceed Value Added growth as demonstrated by performance on state assessments.

**Strategy One:** Implement and monitor standards-based curriculum and assessment through curriculum calendars.

**Adult Indicators:** 100% of the teachers will implement aligned curriculum calendars throughout the district. 100% of the administrators will monitor the use and effectiveness of the calendars throughout the district.

**Student Indicator:** Instruction will be administered to 100% of the students using curriculum calendars throughout the 2016-17 school year. Achievement will be closely monitored through assessment data.

### **Action Steps**

1. Implement curriculum calendars at each grade level.
2. Use Google to collect and share assessment data.
3. Monitor accumulated data from assessments and provide flexible grouping.

**Strategy Two:** All teachers will utilize researched-based Response to Intervention (RTI) strategies.

**Adult Indicator:** 100% of the teachers will differentiate instruction, based on student assessment results.

**Student Indicator:** The IEP, ED, and Lowest 20% student groups and students deemed below at interims will receive intervention.

### **Action Steps**

1. Differentiate instruction and assessments based on student needs.
2. Provide teachers with the performance levels of their students.
3. Examine scheduling and staffing for IEP students.

**Goal 2:** Improve district climate through Positive Behavior Intervention & Support (PBIS).

**Strategy One:** Engage parents in activities designed to share information about their child's academic progress and district events.

**Adult Indicator:** 100% of teachers and administrators will monitor opportunities for stakeholders to communicate feedback.

**Student Indicator:** Students will respond to recognition (e.g., Star Student) of academic progress.

### **Action Steps**

1. Use automated phone system to notify parents about all academic updates.
2. Use the sign in front of the buildings to notify parents about academic news.
3. Implement opportunities to recognize academic success publicly.
4. Redesign and maintain the district's website, including teacher web pages.
5. Send an annual newsletter to all residents of the district and engage families through Twitter.
6. Send a building level newsletter home with report cards quarterly and make it available to residents at local business agencies.
7. Implement a stakeholder survey.
8. Provide social opportunities at school facilities.
