

Red Circle = Case – Someone that has tested positive or has been diagnosed with COVID-19. These people are put in Isolation for the 10/3-day rule.

Yellow Circle = Contact – Someone that had contact within 6 foot without a mask for 15 minutes or longer with a positive case of COVID-19, e.g. coworkers, family members, etc. These people are placed in quarantine for 14 days to determine if they will get ill and become positive for COVID-19 from their exposure with the positive COVID case.

Green Circle = Those people that are family members, coworkers, etc. of the contacts. When these people are only around a “contact” they are not considered at risk unless the “contact” that they are around becomes ill and tests Positive for COVID-19. These people have no restrictions until they are in contact with a Positive COVID-19 case.
