HIGH SCHOOL UPDATES CONT.

Flex Period

We wanted to add more flexibility and student choice in the schedule for next year. With this in mind, we have created a "FLEX" period that will be called "Panther Period". This will allow students to receive extra help if needed, attend school club meetings, participate in assemblies, etc. We are looking forward to this addition to the schedule.

College Credit Plus Math Courses

Starting this school year, we are adding college credit math courses for our students in the high school that are interested in taking math courses for college credit. This expands our opportunities for students looking to take college classes and help with the financial aspect of beginning their college journey.

New Class for Sophomores

We wanted to add more flexibility for our students to explore different career paths as they work through high school. A class to explore STEM opportunities will enable students to learn more about other options that are available to them as they make choices for high school and beyond.

New Class for Seniors

We are moving the Financial Literacy course to senior year for 2023-2024. We believe that is the best time to present valuable information to our students. We are going to pair this course with a new class called "Real World Ready". This course will be all about getting seniors prepared for life after high school. Community Service projects and life skills (basic sewing, basic tools, changing flat tire, checking car fluids, time management, employability skills, self care, CPR/AED, cursive, tie a tie, etc.) will be the focus for this class.

New Structure for 1-to-1 Chromebooks

We have had 1-to-1 Chromebook capability for our student body with chromebook carts available in every classroom. Starting this year, every student will have their own chromebook that they will be responsible for on a daily basis. This allows for students to take responsibility for their own chromebook and access at home as well.

Vape Detectors

We are installing vape detectors in bathrooms across the school and elementary school to help keep our students safe. We will continue to have presentations and assemblies this year to express the health concerns of vaping.
