January 2019 Bullying Report

State law requires Bristol Elementary School to submit a semiannual report regarding bullying incidents. Although the elementary school had several incidents in which students had disagreements and may have initially used the term bullying to describe the incidents, the definition of bullying is a continued or persistent behavior. All of these incidents were addressed in accordance with the the student handbook but most of them did not constitute bullying because they were single incidents rather than a continued, persistent pattern of misbehavior.

One incident was investigated and it was determined that the student had engaged in persistent, continued misbehavior that constituted bullying. The student was disciplined in accordance with the student handbook. Staff members who interact with the student were asked to monitor his actions closely and report any further inappropriate activity to the principal.

Maintaining a safe, positive learning environment is a priority for us at Bristol Elementary School. We have worked to implement and improve our Character Counts and Panther Pride programs to ensure that all children are educated in a safe environment free from harassment and bullying.
