

What your preschooler can be working on to get ready for kindergarten!

- Writing their first and last name and saying their full name.
(Be sure that when they write their name that only the first letter is capitalized and the rest of the name is in lowercase letters.)
- Recite their phone number and address.
- Be able to say the day and month of their birthday.
- Say the days of the week.
- Say the twelve months.
- Recognize colors and also be able to begin to recognize color words.
- Say the alphabet in order, not just sing it.
- Recognize capital and lower case letters.
- Know the sounds of each letter.
- Be able to say words that rhyme.
- Write letters neatly.
(Not too small or too large)
- Count to at least 20.
- Recognize numbers from 0-10.
- Write numbers from 0-10.
- Recognize shapes: circle, square, rectangle, triangle.
- Make a simple pattern.
- Tie their shoes, zip coats, snap or button their pants.
- Coloring neatly and in the lines.
