Schedule Adjustment

In order to accomplish a return to school five days face to face the schedule will need to be adjusted to add additional sections of classes that have a high student count. This will allow us to maintain social distancing by reducing class sizes. Additional course sections of math 7, math 8, algebra I, algebra II, ELA 7, science 7, science 8, chemistry and JHS band have been added and student schedules will be shuffled to keep class sizes manageable. We will also include an additional five minutes in period 6 to allow students to bring a snack as we are aware that a 1:20pm lunch is later than usual.

Changes for students/ parents

- School day ends at 1:20 for students/ buses leave approximately 1:25pm
- Lunches are take home and handed out prior to leaving for the day
- Students may bring snacks to school due to longer period of time between breakfast and lunch - period 6 will be 5 minutes longer to account for a snack time
- Students must leave the building at 1:20pm and cannot stay to wait for practices or younger siblings
- Detentions are limited to only am (7:00)
- No more remote instruction or hybrid school schedule
- Students are encouraged to take breakfast at school

Staff Changes

- Time (teacher and student day remains the same start and finish)
- Class length reduced to 44 minutes from 50 minutes (1st period 45 min for announcements / 6th period is 50 minutes for students to have a snack)
- All teacher lunches are from 1:20 - 1:50
- All teacher planning periods are 1:50 to 2:40
- Additional sections are added for classes with a larger number of students
- Classrooms will be reconfigured to allow optimal spacing
- Additional temporary Social Studies teacher added to reduce 7th and 8th grade class sizes

Safety Measures

- Hallway/stairway traffic patterns remain the same
- Classrooms remain set up to maintain 6 ft distancing
- Cafeteria is not used during lunches to eliminate potential exposure
- Seating charts maintained to assist in contact tracing if needed
- Teacher desks remain further than 6 ft from student desks
- Masks must be worn at all times
- Hand sanitizer stations remain
- Student desks disinfected after each class
- Building sprayed frequently
