I. Community Awareness

- A. Coffee with the board to discuss any community concerns**
- B. Consider holding additional board meetings in West Farmington**
- C. Update district website and keep current**
- D. Recognize more students at board meetings**
- E. Seek opportunities to make the Warren Tribune aware of school events and happenings**
- F. Utilize Twitter and Facebook, consider utilizing other social media platforms**
- G. Produce and disseminate district newsletters biannually**
- H. Continue Very Important Person (VIP) lunches in October for the elementary**
- I. Speak with Amish community leaders regarding enrollment**
- J. Continue Trick or Treat event in the high school**

II. Curriculum

- A. Incorporate Google to collect and share assessment data**
- B. Monitor accumulated data from assessments and provide flexible grouping**
- C. Differentiate instruction and assessments based on students needs**
- D. Implement Multi-Tiered System of Supports (MTSS) to help with the differentiation process**
- E. Provide staff with the performance levels of their students and item analysis reports**
- F. Monitor scheduling and staffing for IEP students**

III. Buildings, Grounds, and Safety

IV. School Finance

- C. Prevent deficit spending through sound financial planning**

V. Technology

- A. Phase in purchases of Chromebooks district wide**
- B. Work on phasing out computer labs as cart access increases**
- C. Monitor the end of life dates for Chromebooks for the purpose of reallocating or replacing them**
- D. Consider an e-Sports league at the High School level**
- E. Look into creating a STEM lab potentially with options such as coding, robotics, drones, etc.**
